The opening of Brahms' Intermezzo in Bb minor is astonishing. Rather than establish the tonic in a traditional fashion, Brahms begins with a ii-i progression in first inversion. The piece is off and running from the start, suggesting multiple tonal regions. The Db as the bass note in m. 1 immediately hints of the relative major

Of the twenty short piano pieces Brahms published as Opp. 116-119, fourteen are titled "Intermezzo.". He abandoned the term "Capriccio" after Op. 116. While an introspective, gentle piece may be implied by "Intermezzo," it was also used for pieces such as Op. 118, No. 6, whose middle section is very passionate. Perhaps he considered the term generic enough to suit his needs.

ABSTRACT: Brahms's Intermezzo op. 119, no. 3 is structured around a motive with two components—one melodic, one harmonic—that operate sometimes separately and sometimes together. The global harmonic trajectory of the piece is embodied in the combination of these two components; local harmonic motion proceeds through an expanded LR-cycle, with periodic short cuts from one zone of the cycle to another.

This Intermezzo in C major is the shortest of the Piano Pieces (4) comprising Brahms' Op. 119 set, lasting only about a minute-and-a-half. It is also the happiest, but for some the relatively brief emotional high expressed here will only reinforce their view that the composer could not write a substantial work of joyous character in the latter stages of his career.

Each of the first three pieces is called an intermezzo, and the last a rhapsody (the German spelling Rhapsodie is also common in English publications). The fact that Brahms originally intended the title 'Capriccio' for his earlier Rhapsody, Op. 79, No. 1, suggests that he used such terms rather loosely.
