The National Curriculum subject of Art and Design embodies Art, Craft and Design. There is no specified expectation as to how much variation in emphasis might be given to each of these aspects. The holistic nature of the subject means that students planning a fine art outcome will be 'designing' as part of their planning.

In KS4 students follow the AQA Art and Design (8201) specification and can opt for either Art, Craft and Design, Graphic Communication or Textile Design which are all skills based courses which allow students to develop knowledge and understanding during the course through a variety of learning experiences and approaches, including engagement with sources.
