The full range of GCSE grades 9 – 1 spans Levels 2-1 of the Regulatory Qualifications Framework in England. Grades 9 – 4 are Level 2, grades 3 – 1 are Level 1.

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General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) graded 9 ...

The reformed GCSE qualifications will be awarded on a grade scale of 9 (the highest grade) to 1 (the lowest). This new scale will be aligned to key grades on the current A\* to G scale. broadly the same proportion of students will achieve a grade 4 and above as currently achieve a grade C and above. broadly the same proportion of students will achieve a grade 7 and above as currently achieve a grade A and above.
