Orthopedic Physical Exam Documentation

Documentation of a normal neck and back exam should look something along the lines of the following: Neck and back have no deformities, external skin changes, or signs of trauma. Curvature of the cervical, thoracic, and lumbar spine are within normal limits. Bony features of the shoulders and hips are of equal height bilaterally.

Sample Normal Exam Documentation. Documentation of a basic, normal extremity exam should look something along the lines of the following: Extremities are atraumatic in appearance without tenderness or deformity. Extremities are without swelling or erythema. Full range of motion is noted to all joints. Muscle strength is 5/5 bilaterally.

The most important observations of the patellar position are made with the patient seated on the examination table, the legs hanging free and the knees flexed to 90 °. The examiner first assesses the patellar position and the position of the tibial tuberosity and patellar ligament by viewing the knee from the lateral aspect.
