Of the two concertos, the Shostakovich made the deepest impression on me -- the soulful threnody of the opening movement is richly communicated, with an undertone of lament, and there seems to be a manic desperation in the passacaglia and finale, where the playing on the upper strings of the violin creates a sense of a spirit on the edge of order and sanity.
