A literary analysis essay is not a rhetorical analysis, nor is it just a summary of the plot or a book review.

The purpose of a literary analysis essay is to carefully examine and sometimes evaluate a work of literature or an aspect of a work of literature. As with any analysis, this requires you to break the subject down into its component parts. Examining the different elements of a piece of literature is not an end in itself but rather a process to help you better appreciate and understand the work of literature as a whole.

HOW TO WRITE A LITERARY ANALYSIS ESSAY

Literary analysis essay structure is similar to many other types of writing. It usually consists of five paragraphs: intro, three body paragraphs, and conclusion. Each of the body paragraphs must focus on a single topic. For example, in one paragraph you review characters and plot, and in the other – literary devices used by the author.

A literary analysis essay is a type of essay which includes an argumentative analysis of a piece of literature. In this kind of essay, the author examines the book, novel, play, etc. analyzing the idea, plot, characters, tone, writing style, devices which the writer uses to narrate his story. This assignment encourages the student to think about the questions "how this book was written?", "why this novel was created by the author?".
